

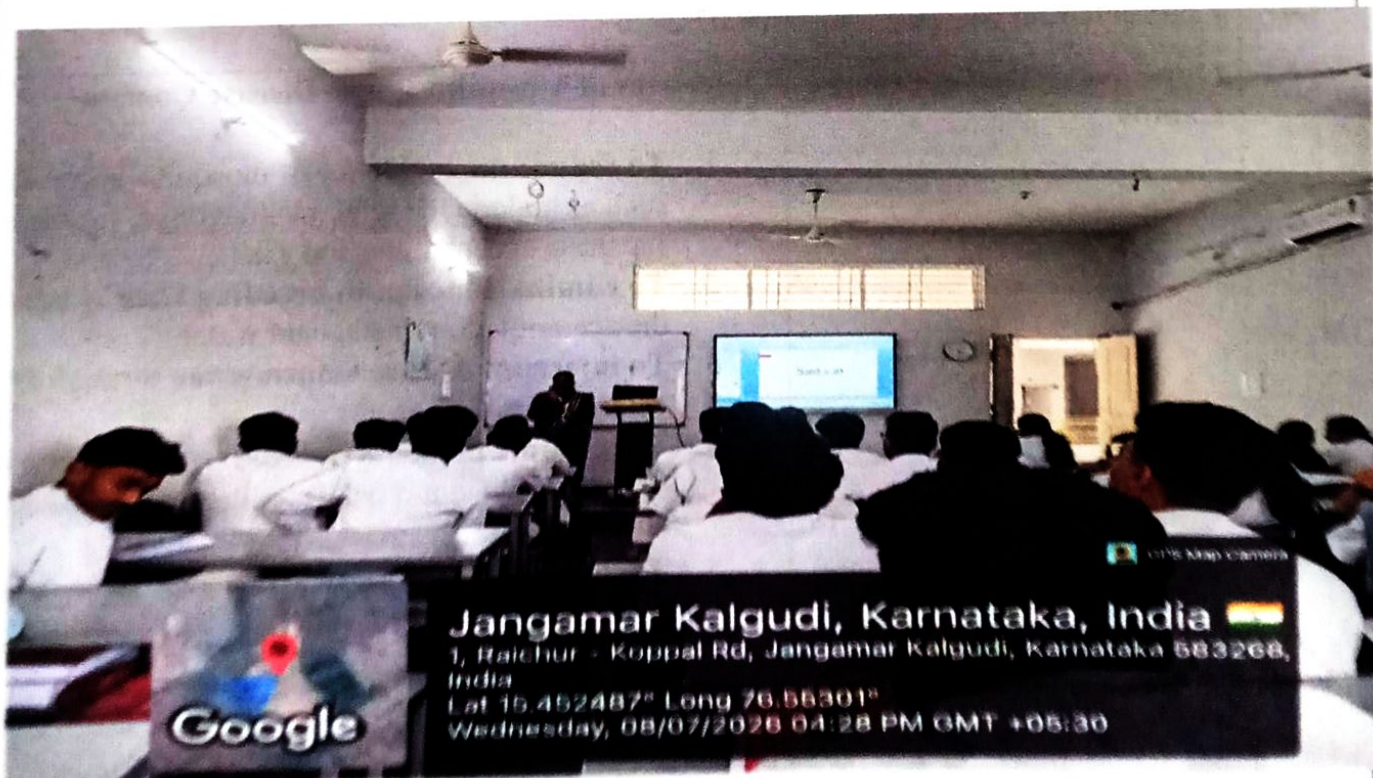


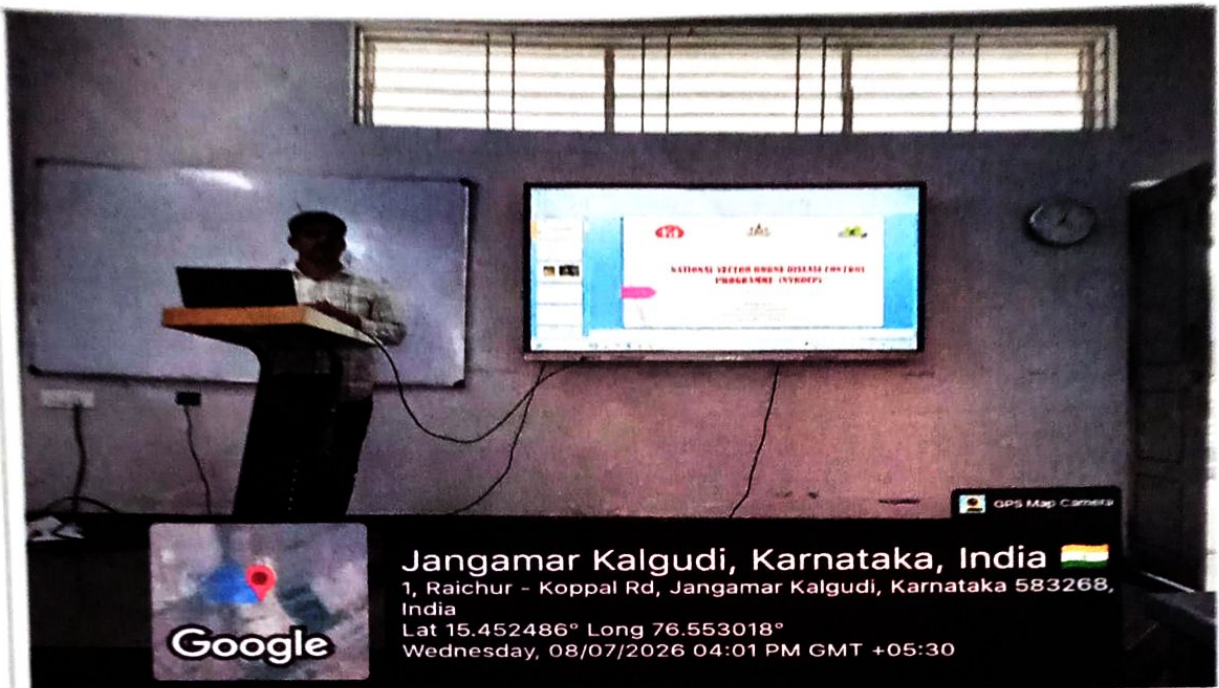

To eliminate mosquito breeding sites by preventing the accumulation of stagnant water. To interrupt disease transmission through effective vector control measures. To promote personal protective measures, including the use of mosquito nets, repellents, and protective clothing. To increase community awareness about mosquito breeding, disease prevention, and early recognition of symptoms.
6	Activities carried out during the program	• Conduct awareness campaigns. • Encourage weekly "Dry Day" to empty and clean water containers. • Participate in community clean-up drives. • Report mosquito breeding sites to local health authorities • Educate the public about mosquito breeding and disease transmission.
